MASSAC COUNTY BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS
AUGUST 5, 2025

Meeting convened at 9:10 A.M. with Jayson Farmer, Jeff Brugger, and Jimmy Burnham present.

On a motion by Mr. Farmer, 2nd by Mr. Brugger, the commissioners approved the minutes as written from the 7/11/2025 meeting.

Kaley McGinnis brought in the GA Check Register to be signed.

County Highway Engineer Brad Watson attended the meeting with claims to be signed.

Sheriff Kaylor attended the meeting with claims to be signed and a list of the week’s bills.

EMA Director Brian Horn attended the meeting with claims to be signed. He reports the river is at 16.0 ft. He gave an update on the George May Lane Siren.

Representatives from the Heroes of Massac Endeavor Statue attended the meeting with updated pictures of what the statue will look like and also an agreement between the county and Heroes of Massac Endeavors for the placement of the statue on the courthouse lawn. The commissioners agreed to put the agreement on the next agenda.

Don Robbins, CEO of Massac Memorial Hospital, attended the meeting with an update. He updated the commissioners on doctors that are new to MMH. The hospital will celebrate their 70th Anniversary in April of 2026. Dr. Patel has stepped down as a board member, so the commissioners will have to appoint someone to fill that vacancy, preferably a physician, but they must live in Massac County. Mr. Robbins also assured the commissioners that regardless of what was being posted on social media, the hospital isn’t going to close anytime soon.

Chairman Burnham signed the Amendment to a Managed Prescription Drug Program Agreement Managed by Script Care, LTD for Massac County.

The commissioners tabled the appointment of someone to fill the Physician Vacancy on the TB Board.

On a motion by Mr. Burnham, 2nd by Mr. Brugger, the commissioners voted to adjourn until the next meeting.
